



Log Cabin Block center variations

Pieced Star center variation 1 - 12" block

Cutting: for 1 block

Fabric A- star background, cut:

1 square $4\frac{1}{4}" \times 4\frac{1}{4}"$ and 4 squares $2" \times 2"$.

Fabric B- red star points, cut:

4 squares $2\frac{3}{8}" \times 2\frac{3}{8}"$.

Fabric C- print star center, cut:

1 square $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$.

Fabric D- white, cut:

1 rectangle $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ and 1 rectangle $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 7\frac{1}{2}"$.

Fabric E- blue 1, cut:

1 rectangle $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 7\frac{1}{2}"$ and 1 rectangle $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$.

Fabric F- light grey, cut:

1 rectangle $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$ and 1 rectangle $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$.

Fabric G- blue 2, cut:

1 rectangle $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$ and 1 rectangle $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$.

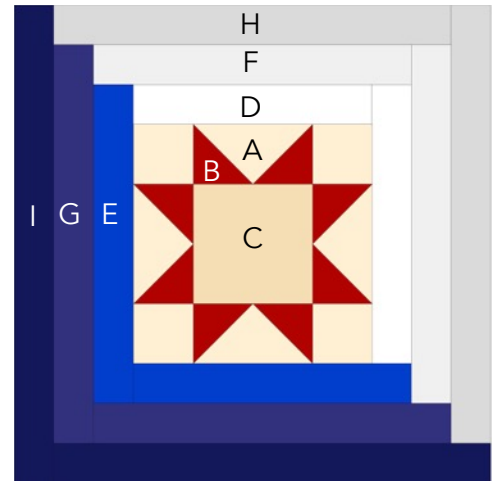
Fabric H- grey, cut:

1 rectangle $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$ and 1 rectangle $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 11\frac{1}{2}"$.

Fabric I- dark blue, cut:

1 rectangle $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 11\frac{1}{2}"$ and 1 rectangle $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$.

Following the make 4 flying geese units at once method, use the 1 fabric A $4\frac{1}{4}" \times 4\frac{1}{4}"$ square and the 4 fabric B $2\frac{3}{8}" \times 2\frac{3}{8}"$ squares to make 4 flying geese units.



Pieced Star center variation 2 - 12" block

Cutting: for 1 block

Fabric A 1- *star background light, cut:*

1 square $4\frac{1}{4}" \times 4\frac{1}{4}"$, 1 square $2" \times 2"$ and 1 square $2\frac{3}{8}" \times 2\frac{3}{8}"$. (You will have 2 flying geese left over.)

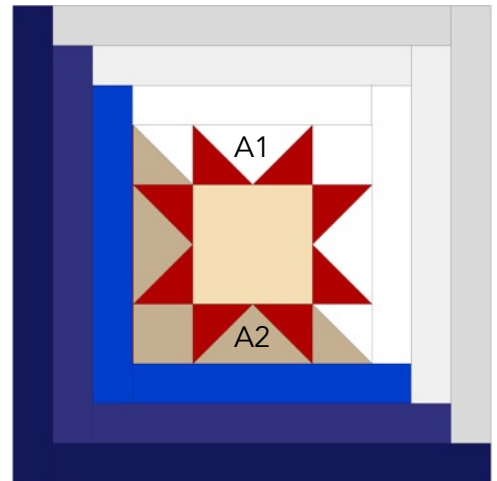
Fabric A 2- *star background dark, cut:*

1 square $4\frac{1}{4}" \times 4\frac{1}{4}"$, 1 square $2" \times 2"$ and 1 square $2\frac{3}{8}" \times 2\frac{3}{8}"$. (You will have 2 flying geese left over.)

The rest of the fabrics are the same as variation 1.

Make 2 flying geese units with background A1 and 2 flying geese units with background A2.

Use the background A1 and A2 $2\frac{3}{8}" \times 2\frac{3}{8}"$ squares to make 2 half square triangle units.



Pieced Heart center variation - 12" block

Cutting: for 1 block

Fabric A- red 1, cut:

2 rectangles 2" x 3 ½".

Fabric B- red 2, cut:

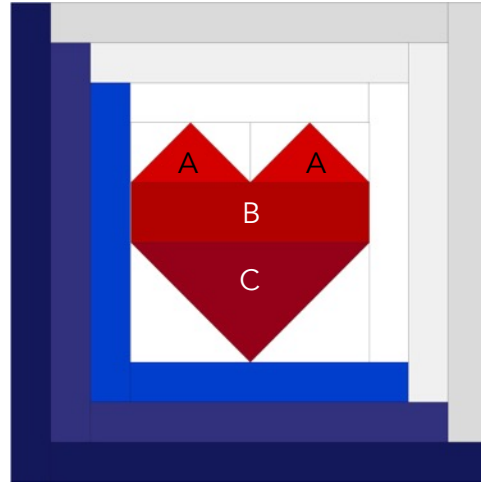
1 rectangle 2" x 6 ½".

Fabric C- red 3, cut:

1 rectangle 3 ½" x 6 ½".

Fabric D- white, cut:

4 squares 2" x 2" and 2 squares 3 ½" x 3 ½".



Cut the rest of the fabrics the same as the star variation 1 including the fabric D white 1 ½" rectangles. Follow the flying geese stitch and flip directions to make 2 small flying geese units using the fabric A 2" x 3 ½" rectangles and the 4 fabric D 2" x 2" squares. Make 1 large flying geese unit using the fabric C 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle and the 2 fabric D 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares.

Appliqué Star center variation - 12" block

Cutting: for 1 block

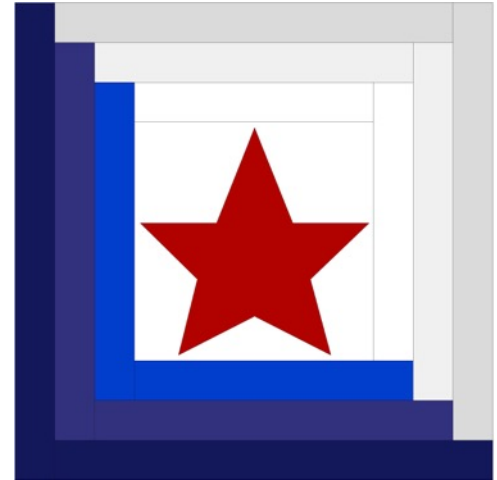
Fabric A- star background, cut:

1 square 7"x 7".

Fabric B- star, cut:

1 square 7"x 7".

The rest of the fabrics D-I are the same as variation 1 (skip fabric C).



After you fuse the heart to the background and stitch around the shape as desired, trim the star unit to 6 ½" x 6 ½" square.

Appliqué Heart center variation - 12" block

Cutting: for 1 block

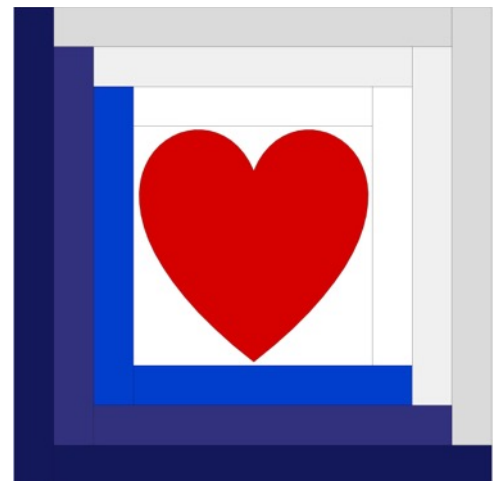
Fabric A- heart background, cut:

1 square 7"x 7"

Fabric B- heart, cut:

1 square 7"x 7".

The rest of the fabrics D-I are the same as variation 1 (skip fabric C).



After you fuse the heart to the background and stitch around the shape as desired, trim the heart unit to 6 ½" x 6 ½" square.
